CONSTITUTION

1. Name of Organization

Brampton Historical Society

2. Intent

A non-profit organization dedicated to the celebration and preservation of the heritage of Brampton and a member of the Ontario Historical Society.

3. Objectives

- a) to promote public interest in the history of the Brampton area;
- b) to advocate and participate in activities which contribute to the preservation of heritage resources in the
Brampton area;
- c) to publish and reprint material related to local history as may from time to time be decided upon by the
Members and to arrange distribution of the same;
- d) to establish a foundation for the funding of projects related to the preservation and promotion of local
heritage;
- e) to compile and publish research on subjects relating to the history of the Brampton area;
- f) to document historical resources in the Brampton area;
- g) to work in conjunction with other organizations, having a common interest in local history, towards fulfilling the objectives of the Society.

4. Membership

Membership in this Society shall be open to any person interested in the history of the area, and such person may be enrolled as a Member upon the receipt of an application and the annual family membership fee determined by the Board of Directors from time to time.

5. Officers

The Officers shall be: President, Vice President, Membership Secretary, Recording Secretary, Treasurer.

6. Board of Directors

Officers plus Chairpersons of Committees and other Directors, up to a total of twelve persons. Fifty Percent of the total number of directors plus one shall constitute a quorum of the Board.
